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Additional file 7. Reasons for exclusion at full-text and post-hoc exclusions

Full-text not available (n=164)

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Inadequate timepoints of follow-up (n=6)

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Other reasons for exclusion - no or inadequate synthesis across studies for relevant outcomes (n=22)

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Additional exclusions

Irrelevant intervention (e.g., relapse prevention, prenatal ultrasonography) (n=10)

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Reported analyses combine trials of various smoking cessation interventions such that the effect of each cannot be isolated (n=4)

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Inadequate syntheses (data cannot be collected at face-value) (n=1)

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Largely indirect (majority of studies in smokers <18 years; some trials include adults but only up to 20 years of age) (n=1)

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Candidate review on e-cigarettes selected for updating (n=2)

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Cochrane overview superseded by updated versions of included reviews (n=2)

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Cochrane review - Subpopulations not of interest and/or comparative effectiveness only (n=23)

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Non-Cochrane systematic reviews (n=290)

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
